The Role of the Health and Safety Governor

The Health and Safety governor is appointed by the whole governing body.

1. The role of the Health and Safety governor is to:
 - help the governing body understand, and monitor the Nursery's Health and Safety;
 - ensure that regular consideration is given to Health and Safety matters;
 - act as a link, alongside the headteacher, between the school and the governing body on Health and Safety matters;
 - remind the governing body to give due priority to improvements to Health and Safety when considering budget allocations;
 - represent the governing body in developments with parents on Health and Safety matters;
 - represent the governing body in developments with the wider community on Health and Safety matters;
 - attend organised training events related to Health and Safety;
 - ask questions about current policy and practice with regard to Health and Safety;

- report to governor colleagues on the progress and effectiveness of Health and Safety;

2. The "Health and Safety governor" might:

- meet with the headteacher/Designated First Aider/Site Supervisor from time to time to become better informed about Health and Safety;
- report to the governing body/Resources Committee as agreed;
- meet with LCC Health and Safety/Property representatives to consider health and safety matters;
- try to attend some INSET courses.
