



## The Role of the Mathematics Governor

The Mathematics Governor is appointed by the whole governing body.

1. The role of the Mathematics Governor is to:
  - ask questions about current policy and practice with regard to the teaching of Mathematics;
  - report to governor colleagues on the progress and effectiveness of the strategy; and supporting and promoting the involvement with parents.
2. The Mathematics Governor *might*:
  - meet with the Mathematics co-ordinator at least termly to discuss how the implementation of the provision is working;
  - meet with the headteacher from time to time to become better informed about school Mathematics issues;
  - use termly visits to talk with teachers and see some Mathematics practice;
  - report to the governing body/curriculum committee as agreed.
