We have welcomed 2 new staff at Rockwood this month!

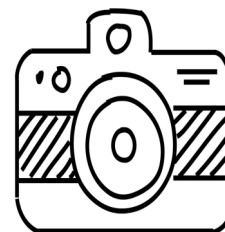
George is our new After School Lead, he also leads Blue group in the afternoons.

Safety Reminders

- Please can parents remember to label all children's belongings with their names.
- Please be careful if you are approaching nursery in a car, children are difficult to see and can run out unexpectedly. If you can, park further away and do not turn around near the school gateway.
- If you are walking, please hold your child's hand, Kingsland Road can be busy and with parked cars a child can run into a road very quickly.
- Do not use your phone on the nursery school grounds - this is a government rule, not ours!
- Please do not bring your dog with you - no matter how gentle you think your dog is, it can scare small children and incidents can happen, it is best avoided by leaving your dog at home.
- Please can parents leave through the front door when dropping off and picking up children.
